SUBJECT: Recognition Certificate for the School under sub-rule (1) of rule 11 of Right of  
Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of  
Section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application of acknowledgement dated 21-03-2022 and subsequent correspondence with the authority in this regard, I convey the grant of provisional recognition to the Auckland Grammar Sen. Sec School, for Class III to XII for a period of Three Years w.e.f 01.04.2022 To 31.03.2024.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions namely:-

1. The grant for recognition is non-revocable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognition after beyond Class XII.
2. The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
3. The School shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25 % of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till completion. Provided that in case of primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed as per Section 12(2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursement school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The Society-School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child to his or her parents or guardians to any onerous procedure.
6. The School shall not deny admission-
  - a) To any child for lack of age proof.
  - b) If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
  - c) On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
7. The School shall ensure that-
  - a) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
  - b) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
  - c) No child is required to join any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
  - d) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23.
8. Inclusion of Students with disabilities special needs as per provision of the Act;
9. The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications and are provided with remuneration salary and allowances as laid under section 26(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teacher who at the commencement of this Act did not possess minimum required qualification shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 3 years.
10. The teacher performs its duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act;
11. The teacher shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.

6. The School shall follow its syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
7. The School shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the section 19 of the Act.
8. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities reported in the time of last inspection are as given below:

9. No unrecognised classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.
10. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purpose of education and skill development.
11. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Act No. XXI of 1860) or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
12. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or no other persons.
13. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer, Elementary and Secondary every year.
14. The recognition Code Number allotted to your school is RTE/52... (This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office).
15. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Directorate of Education-District Education Officer/Block Primary Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government/Local Authority as may be issued to ensure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
16. Removal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
17. Your school shall submit the Building safety certificate and fire safety certificate in this office every year.

Note:- This conditional provisional recognition is granted on basis of self declaration certificate filed by the school. If later on it is found wrong then above said provisional recognition can be cancelled.
