Subject: Recognition Certificate for the School under sub-rule (6) of rule 11 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of Section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.
Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application with declaration dated 29.4.2022 and subsequent correspondence with the school/office in this regard, I convey the grant for provisional recognition to the Auckland Grammar Sen. Sec. School, for Class I to VIII for a period of Three Years w.e.f. 01.04.2023 To 31.03.2024.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions/terms:-

- The grant for recognition is not exclusive and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize all those beyond Class VIII.
- The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
- The School shall admit in class I, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion. Provided that in case of pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
- For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed as per Section 12 (2) of the Act. To receive such reimbursement school shall provide a separate bank account.
- The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child to fee or fee parents or guardians to any recurring provision.
- The School shall not deny admission:
 - To any child for lack of age proof.
 - If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed for admission.
 - On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of them.
- The School shall ensure that:
 - No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 21.
 - Inclusion of Students with disabilities/special needs as per provisions of the Act.
 - The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications and are provided with minimum salary and allowances as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 3 years.
 - The teacher performs its duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act.
 - The teachers shall not engage himself or herself for private teaching activities.

8. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.

9. The School shall enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as provided in the section 19 of the Act.

10. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act. The facilities specified in the form of list specified are as given below:-

11. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the name of school.

12. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purpose education and skill development.

13. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Act No. XXI of 1860) or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.

14. The School is not run for profit by any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.

15. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer, Elementary and Secondary every year.

16. The recognition Code Number allotted to your school is RTE/52... (This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with this office).

17. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the Department of Education District Education Officer Block Primary Education Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the State Government/Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.

18. Removal of Registration of Society if any, be removed.

19. Your school shall submit the building safety certificate and fire safety certificate in this office every year.

Note: This conditional provisional recognition is granted on basis of self declaration/certificate filed by the school. If later on it is found wrong then above said provisional recognition can be cancelled.
